What is a Community Bike and Safety Event?

Started in 2013, the Community Bike and Safety Events bring together Streets, Fire, Police, Parks, Library, and NSD to work with the eight Council District Offices to reach out to the community and provide bike and other safety related information, goods and services. There are eight days of events (one per council district). They are on Saturday's in March and April. Each council district will have three events over the course of the day to reach as many constituents as possible. All 28 Public School Districts, charter, private and parochial schools are invited to participate.
