

PROJECT INFORMATION

Phase II of the Roosevelt Street Improvement Project includes:

- installation of new storm drain pipe and associated laterals, catch basins and manholes between 4th and 5th Streets
- removal of the existing dry well in 5th Street just north of Roosevelt Street
- narrowing of the existing street toward centerline
- addition of ADA pedestrian ramps at the intersections
- addition of bike lanes on both sides of the street
- widening the existing sidewalk on the north side of the street, and planting new trees in tree grates between 4th and 5th Streets
- widening the sidewalks on the south side of the street, and adding metered parking
- adding new LED street and pedestrian lighting
- adding new traffic signals at 4th Street

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The contractor will begin storm drain system replacement work between 4th and 5th Streets on Monday, September 14, 2015. This portion of work is anticipated to last approximately 45 days.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

Traffic will be restricted adjacent to the contractors work area. However, one lane in each direction will be maintained at all times.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

Pedestrian access will be maintained on both sides of Roosevelt Street.
