## **Project Update**

The contractor began the administrative portion of the two projects in mid March. Materials and procedures to be used for each specific restoration process have been submitted for approval and parts and materials have been ordered. The lead times for delivery are lengthy because of the uniqueness of the lights and poles.

Two concrete poles have been removed and are being used to create molds for the manufacturing of replica poles. The replica poles will be installed throughout the project area where concrete poles are missing or are beyond repair.

Although the contractor is not present in the field at this time, the project is on schedule. The contractor anticipates beginning field work in late May. Prior to work beginning on each block, residents will be notified in writing. The anticipated completion of the two projects is November, 2011.
