



## **Deadline Extension Requests**

Deadlines are not automatically extended. Failure to notify the City of Phoenix Environmental Services Division (ESD) that required actions cannot be completed by the specified deadline(s) shall be considered noncompliance with Phoenix City Code Chapter 28 and may result in further enforcement action.

The ESD will consider requests for deadline extensions only if the following are provided:

- The extension request is made in writing or email prior to the specified deadline date.
- A specific amount of time or a specific date is included in the written request (i.e. when the work will be completed).
- A detailed explanation outlining the need for the deadline extension is included in the written request.
- Documentation supporting the reason(s) for the requested deadline extension accompanies the written request.

Examples of supporting documentation include, but are not limited to:

- Copies of bids/proposals from licensed contractors or plumbers
- Copies of a signed contract for construction with a licensed contractor or plumber
- Copies of documents indicating a transfer of business ownership

Note: If an extension is requested, you will be operating <u>at your own risk</u>. If a problem (blockage, overflow, etc.) occurs after you are aware of the issue, you will be potentially responsible for any damages occurred due the problem and a deadline extension may be denied.
