
PROJECT 1 / PHASE A



N. 20th Street Road Closure Resident Access Only

Due to soil conditions the City of Phoenix is closing N. 20th Street from E. Glendale Avenue to E. Myrtle Avenue during working hours (6 a.m. - 4 p.m.), Resident access will be maintained. The closure will occur 1 block at a time as they move north from E. Glendale Avenue to E. Myrtle Avenue. **The closure will start on Thursday, June 11, 2020.**

- Crews onsite will work with residents to allow access to their homes.
- Sidewalks on the east side of N. 20th Street will remain open for pedestrian traffic.
- During non-working hours, N. 20th Street will be opened back up to one-way northbound traffic.
