# To submit plans over the counter the following must apply:

- 1) The job is small and involves **plumbing only**.
- 2) For grease interceptors **only like for like replacements can be done over the counter.**

### **ELECTRONIC PLAN REVIEW**

PLANS THAT REQUIRE MAJOR PLUMBING CHANGES INCLUDING INSTALLATION OF A NEW GREASE INTERCEPTOR MUST BE SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY NOTE: OVER THE COUNTER SUBMITTALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR MAJOR PLUMBING CHANGES

# To submit for electronic plan review:

- Begin your submittal by clicking https://appssecure.phoenix.gov/PDD/EPR/Home/Dashboard to complete the online application. Once completed, you will receive an invitation from ProjectDox (with a temporary password) to upload drawings.

## **ALL PLAN REVIEWS**

A CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PLAN REVIEWS.

# Submitted permits must include the following:

**Business Information:** 

- 1) Name of business
- 2) Address of business. Including the Number, Direction, Street Name, Street Type, and Zip Code (include the Suite Number if the business is one of several suites at the address).
- 3) Show all existing Grease Bearing Fixtures (GBF)\* on the plans that are within the restaurant.
- 4) The plans should also show that ALL GBF are routed to appropriately sized Grease Trap or Grease Interceptor.
- 5) The plans must have an orientation mark (an indication of North for example).

#### The Pretreatment Device

- 1) The name of the manufacturer of the pretreatment device.
- 2) The Model Number and size of the pretreatment device. Note that all pretreatment devices must be pre-approved by the City of Phoenix Environmental Services Division.
- 3) Gravity Grease Interceptor: The device must be an approved model from a City of Phoenix approved vender. The ESD can provide a list of approved devices and venders. The smallest model Grease interceptor allowed by the Environmental Services Division is 2-compartment 2-man-way 500-gallon unit.
- 4) Hydromechanical Grease Trap: The device must be PDI, IAPMO (International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials) approved or UPC (Uniform Plumbing Code) listed.

#### **Other Considerations**

- 1) If there is any re-piping involved, then the drawings must be submitted for review. A Plumbing Floor Plan Layout and an Isometric Drawing must be included in the submittal for review. (For example, a fixture that must be rerouted OR a new fixture added then an Isometric Drawing must be included that depicts the pipe size and venting. If all the plumbing is to remain the same with only a different pretreatment device, then an only Plumbing Floor Plan Layout will be required.
- 2) If the device is being installed because an Environmental Services Division inspector made installation a requirement, please submit a copy of the Commercial Inspection Report.
- 3) ALL DRAWINGS MUST BE LEGIBLE OR THE REVIEW WILL BE DENIED.

Please call (602) 495-0278 at least 24-hours in advance to schedule an appointment such that an Environmental Services Division inspector can be on hand to conduct the ESD portion of the review.

\*GREASE BEARING FIXTURES (GBF) include floor sinks, floor drains, mop sinks, trough sinks, trough drains, pre-wash sinks, prep sinks, pot sinks, can wash sinks, dishwashers, garbage disposals, etc. in the kitchen prep or wash area. Hand wash sinks do not apply. Condensate or cooler drain lines shall not be routed to the MS/GW line.
